Cycling

Members of Shandon Residents' Association had a site meeting on Wednesday 31st March with Ciaran Fallon, the Dublin City Council cycling officer, the Area engineer and traffic personnel, to discuss ways in which the cycle facilities in Phibsborough / Cabra / Royal Canal can be improved. We are lobbying for more cycle lanes, better bike parking and more db stations.

Playground in Mount Bernard Park

Members of the Residents Association have been working closely with Anne O'Brien, Dublin City Council Parks Development Officer, on the design and development of playground facilities in Mount Bernard Park. Anne now plans to convene a committee with involvement from children and youth workers in Cabra, and to organise a half day workshop with local children to design and implement natural play structures for the park. Implementation will involve voluntary input from members of the community.

Draft City Development Plan: The Residents' Association prepared a submission to track contradictions, convergences and omissions in context of the Phibsborough LAP and is currently preparing a policy amendment to the draft Development Plan stipulating that the provisions of the LAP will apply until a review takes place.

Hopping for Haiti

A group of young Shandon residents and their friends from the wider area, organised a "Hop for Haiti" on Saturday 23rd January 2010. These youngsters raised a total of €188 by hopping on pogo sticks and on one leg. The collection was donated to Oxfam Haiti Earthquake Fund later that day. Parking

24 hour / 7 days per week Disc parking was introduced to Shandon Road at very short notice. This is likely to have a negative impact on parking in Shandon Park and Shandon Drive.
